

THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 43 OF 2015¹
Concerning the fees to be charged by the Regulatory and Supervisory Bureau for the Electricity and Water Sector in the Emirate of Dubai

We, Hamdan Bin Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai and Chairman of the Executive Council,
Having perused Law No. 3 of 2003, concerning the Establishment of the Executive Council of Dubai,
And Law No. 14 of 2009 concerning the Pricing of Government Services in the Emirate of Dubai and its amendments,
And Law No. 19 of 2009 concerning Establishing the Supreme Council of Energy,
And Law No. 35 of 2009 concerning the Management of Public Funds of the Government of Dubai and its amendments,
And Law No. 6 of 2011 Regulating the Participation of the Private Sector in Electricity and Water Production in the Emirate of Dubai,
And Executive Council Resolution No. 2 of 2010 For The Establishment of the Regulatory and Supervisory Bureau for the Electricity and Water Sector in the Emirate of Dubai, hereinafter referred to as the “Bureau”,

Resolved the following:

Fees
Article (1)

- a. The Bureau shall charge for issuing electricity and water production licences referred to in the attached schedule, the fees associated with each of them.
- b. In addition to the fee referred to in clause (a) of this article, the applicant for an electricity generation or water desalination licence shall bear all costs associated with application assessment if the bureau seeks the assistance of experts to assess the application, on the condition that the bureau informs the applicant beforehand.

Devolution of Fees
Article (2)

The fees and penalties collected pursuant to this resolution shall devolve to the account of the public treasury of the Government of Dubai.

Issuance of Executing Decisions
Article (3)

The Supreme Council of Energy shall issue the necessary decisions to execute the provisions of this Resolution, including specifying the conditions and procedures for issuing licences.

Publication and Entry into Force
Article (4)

This Resolution shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into force on the day on which it is published.

1	Application for Electricity Generation or Water Desalination.	20,000
2	Issue or renewal of an Electricity Generation licence for a generation capacity of 500 kilowatts to 1 megawatt.	1,000
3	Issue or renewal of an Electricity Generation licence for a generation capacity of 1 megawatt to 10 megawatts.	10,000
4	Issue or renewal of an Electricity Generation licence for a generation capacity of 10 megawatts to 50 megawatts.	30,000
5	Issue or renewal of an Electricity Generation licence for a generation capacity greater than 50 megawatts.	30,000 dirhams upon issuance or renewal of a licence, plus 600 dirhams for each megawatt in excess of 50 megawatts due upon the start of actual production of electricity.
6	Issue or renewal of a Water Desalination licence for a production capacity less than 2 million litres per day.	5,000
7	Issue or renewal of a Water Desalination licence for a production capacity of 2 to 10 million litres per day.	30,000
8	Issue or renewal of a Water Desalination licence for a production capacity greater than 10 million litres per day.	30,000 dirhams upon issuance or renewal of a licence, plus 2,000 dirhams for each 1 million litres in excess of 10 million litres per day due upon the start of actual production of desalinated water.
