However, complaints that are raised prematurely will not be processed, so please ensure every effort is made to solve your issue directly with the service provider.

The RSB encourages district cooling providers to adopt energy-efficient technologies and practices to minimize environmental impact. By promoting sustainable practices, the RSB contributes to Dubai's overall efforts toward a greener and more sustainable future.
